#### Part 7 - Permit Specifics

Note: All permits issued will be valid until the end of the vehicle(s) eligibility to operate under the grandfathering provisions of O. Reg. 413/05, s.34.

Grandfathering for trucks, trailers in a truck-trailer combination, buses or recreational vehicles manufactured before July 1, 2011 operating without the need for permit ends after December 31, 2020.

Trucks, trailers in a truck-trailer combination, buses or recreational vehicles manufactured between January 2006 and June 2011 are eligible for extended grandfathering by special permit and may continue to operate at existing weight allowances until the end of the year in which the vehicle reaches 15 years of age.

A trailer in a truck-trailer combination is understood as not having a connecting fifth wheel.

Concrete mixer trucks fitted with a revolving drum, as well as tank full or pony trailers, manufactured between January 2001 and June 2011 are eligible for extended grandfathering by special permit and may continue to operate at existing weight allowances until the end of the year in which the vehicle reaches 20 years of age.

Depending on the type of truck and trailer, some dimensional limits for SPIF compliance do not apply until December 31, 2025. Details are provided in the Exceptions section of the corresponding SPIF vehicle.

For truck-trailer combinations where one of the vehicles is eligible for extended grandfathering and the other is SPIF compliant, permit is required to the eligible vehicle for extended grandfathering.

The operator to which this permit is issued will be exempt from *Highway Traffic Act* Regulation 413/05 section 21 when operating a truck, a trailer in a truck-trailer combination, a bus or a recreational vehicle.

The permit is valid only if the date of manufacture on the manufacturer's label affixed to the vehicle matches the month and year of manufacture specified on the permit.

The permit is issued to the VIN number of the vehicle and, as such, it is transferable upon transfer of ownership. No modifications are required with the ownership transfer. Particularly, the validity date of the permit will remain unchanged.
